We, Silverlit Toys Manufactory Limited, are a company incorporated under the laws of Hong Kong and carry on business as a designer, manufacturer and distributor of various high technology R/C Toys, including the well-known super-light weight toy helicopter named "PicooZ":



When creating the main and tail propellers ("Propellers") and the system for the Propellers ("Propeller System") for the "PicooZ", substantive independent effort, skill and judgment were devolved. We hereby announce that we are the owner of the copyright in the following Propellers and Propeller System:



The intellectual property rights, including innovations, copyright and design of the Propellers have been registered and / or are in the course of registration in different countries of the world.

To protect copyright, interest of our customers and the public at large, we hereby declare that we shall take out all possible legal actions to stop infringing activities and will sue the retail stores and the suppliers for their dealings in or with infringing copies of the "PicooZ", the Propellers, and / or the Propeller System.

Recently, we discovered that toy helicopters and / or flying objects bearing the identical design and / or substantively similar design to the Propellers and / or the Propeller System are being sold in the market.

On 20th June 2007, the U.S. Court entered a stipulated permanent injunction against Hobbytron.com permanently enjoining it from selling or advertising the below products and ordering it to pay US\$200,000.00 damages.



On 26th June 2007, we filed a lawsuit against Powersources Enterprises, Henfair Remote Control Technology Research & Development Limited and Billion Gate (Holdings) Group Limited for copyright infringement of the Propellers in the High Court of Hong Kong. On 29th June 2007, the Honorable Mr. Justice Yam ordered an interim injunction order restraining the defendants of the said lawsuit, their partners and/or directors and employees from further dealings in or with the following toy helicopters and remote controllers:



On 27th June 2007, we filed another lawsuit against one retail store named Kam Fai Toys for infringement of registered design of the "PicooZ".

On 7th July 2007, we also filed a lawsuit against one other retail store named Perfect Garage for infringement of registered design and copyright of the "PicooZ".

On 10th July 2007, we filed another lawsuit against one retail store named For Shun Computer Technology for infringement of registered design of the "PicooZ".

We hereby declare that: mere modifications of the shape or dimension of the stabilizer or main rotor still amount to acts of infringement. We shall aggressively pursue legal actions against infringing manufacturers and dealers.
